CONSTITUTIONAL AMMENDMENTS TO THE MBOD 2020

1. Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. At the 13th Session of the GC held in August 2024, the following constitutional amendments received two-thirds majority vote:

†16.1, †16. 3, †21, †9 Article 1

2. Having received a further two-thirds affirmative vote of the aggregate numbers of all 6 Annual Conferences held between November and December, the amendments now fulfil the criteria in accordance to †43. Article I, and shall become effective January 1, 2025.
