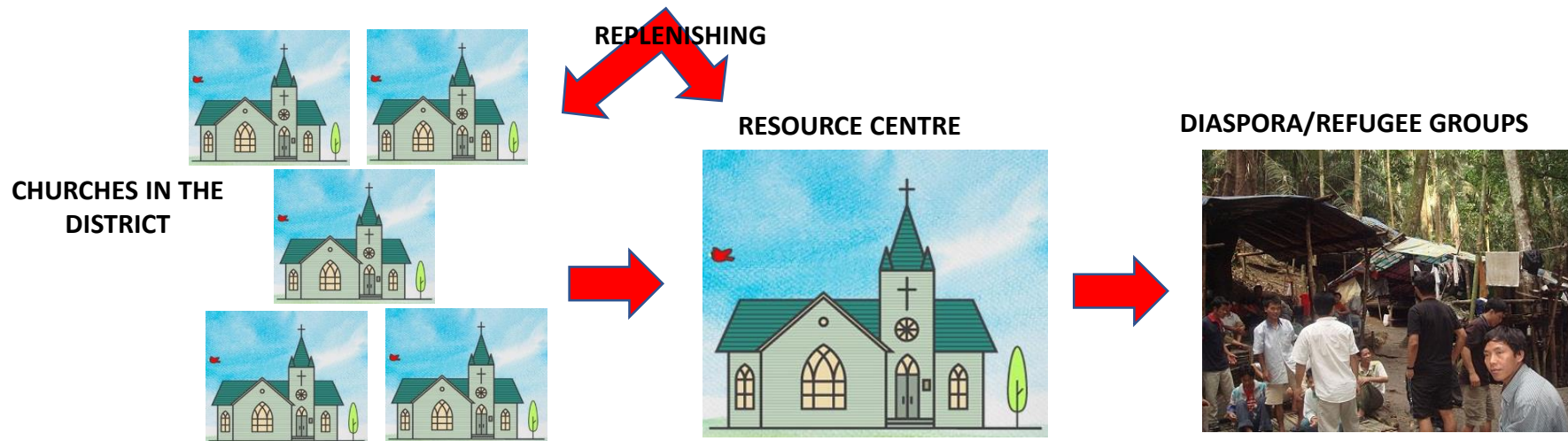

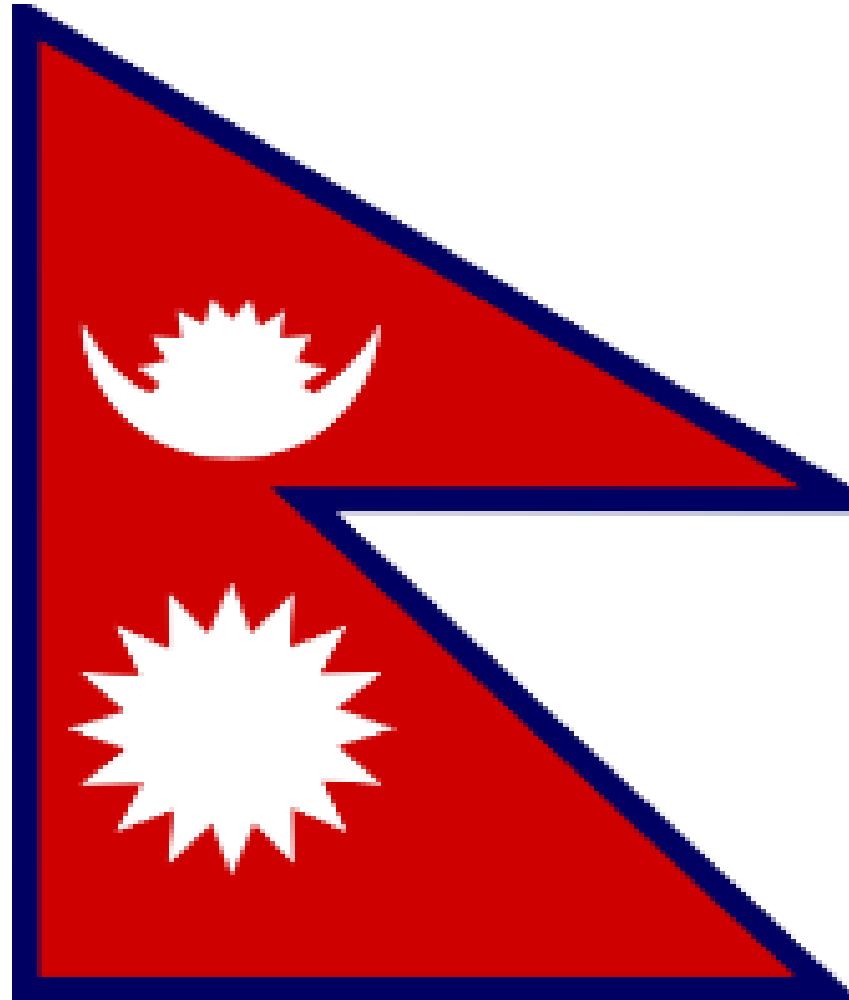

GIFT OF HOPE 2022

- We've sent a letter dated 8th Sept 2021, followed by a memo on 6th Jan 2022 regarding our GOH project updates...

Date: 8th September 2021

To Dear Pastors, LCEC Leaders and Members,

Greetings in the blessed name of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

In our recent MMM Board Meeting, we decided on these 2 important matters which we would like to keep our Pastors, Leaders and churches informed.

Item No.1

We would like to thank all our churches for contributing to GOH 2021 which is now expanded to Sri Lanka and Nepal besides our pre-existing partner country, Myanmar. Despite the challenging times of ongoing pandemic, by God's grace we managed to receive sponsors from our churches, individuals and well-wishers for 1708 children! As we receive, we have blessed 100 children from Sri Lanka in the early January 2021 and 150 Nepal children especially from the Badi community in April 2021. However, we could not send our contributions for Myanmar children due to underlying reasons:

1. The military government just took over the country on February 2021.
2. The pandemic which caused overwhelming rise of Covid-19 cases and deaths in Myanmar.
3. All the sources to send money via banks and other legal merchants were closed and strictly monitored by the government.
4. Our Myanmar team were not able to travel for the GOH purchasing or for the distribution due to lock down and restriction of travel.

Therefore, decision was made through our Board meeting held on 31st July 2021 to hold the channeling of funds to Myanmar till further notice. This to ensure that all the funds that we have collected is sent and received safely by the Myanmar team and is spent in the right and optimal way. We will keep all churches posted on updates regarding this matter. Kindly continue to pray for Myanmar.

MEMO GIFT OF HOPE 2021

Dear Pastors, Mission Leaders and Members

We want to thank all of you for giving generously towards GOH 2021. Despite the ongoing pandemic, by God's grace we managed to receive sponsors from churches, individuals and well-wishers for **1708 children!**

Through this contribution, we have blessed **100 children** from Sri Lanka and **150 children** from Nepal this year.

However, we were not able to send the fund to Myanmar due to the nation's political instability and travel restrictions there as mentioned in our letter dated 8th Sept 2021.

The Board of Missions/MMM thus has decided to put on hold the RM150 collection for Gift of Hope(GOH) 2022.

We would instead use the remaining funds gathered in 2021 to be channeled to children of our GOH partner countries. We will keep all churches posted on the upcoming progress of Gift of Hope 2022.

Please continue to pray for this ministry.

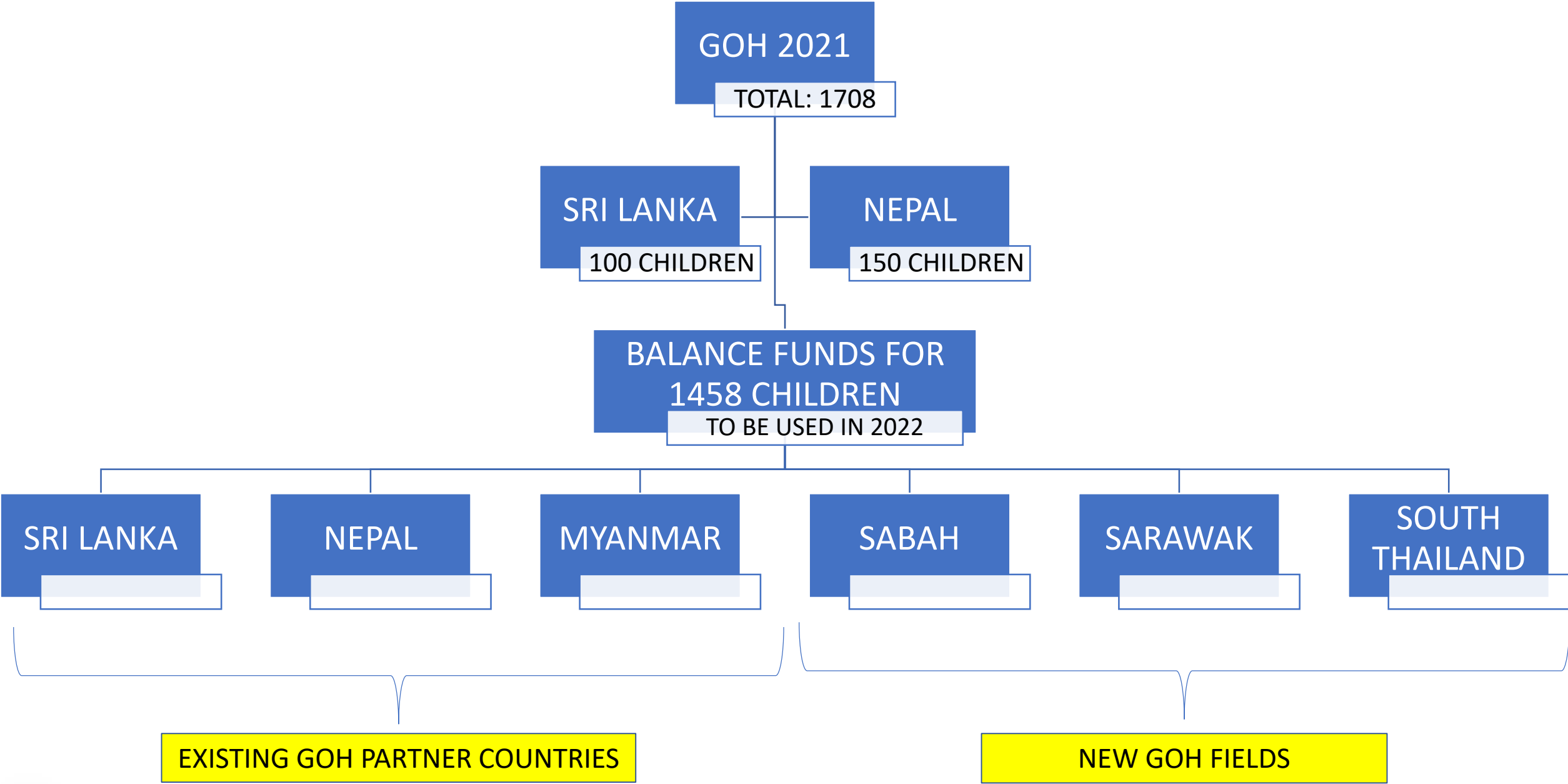

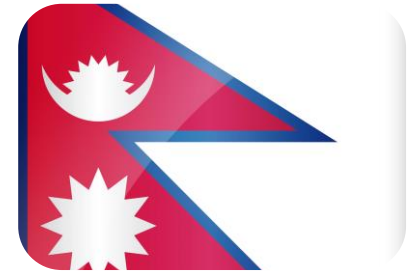

- Myanmar is still in difficult situation since February 2021. At present, the **political crisis** is still ongoing and the situation has become worse.
- 1. The protest and fights in so districts such as Kachin, Karan , Chin and other areas especially in Border Areas. People are **in danger and living in fear**, houses are burnt down and people are staying in jungles.
- 2. Please pray for the **young people** who are sacrificing their lives for the country. Some of the Methodist Theological Institute students are also involved in these conflict.
- 3. There are **bomb explosions** almost everyday, please pray to stop the crisis and find ways for peace.

 - 6. Many people are **jobless**, people struggle to meet their daily needs. Prices are increasing day by day as most of the workplaces are closed. Crime activities such as kidnapping & corruption are increasing.
 - 7. **Electricity supply** is cut off very often & **internet** prices have hiked; it effects the worship services and all areas of life.
 - Please pray for Myanmar, the hard times for nearly one year: Spiritually, mentally, physically, and uncertainty of the future...

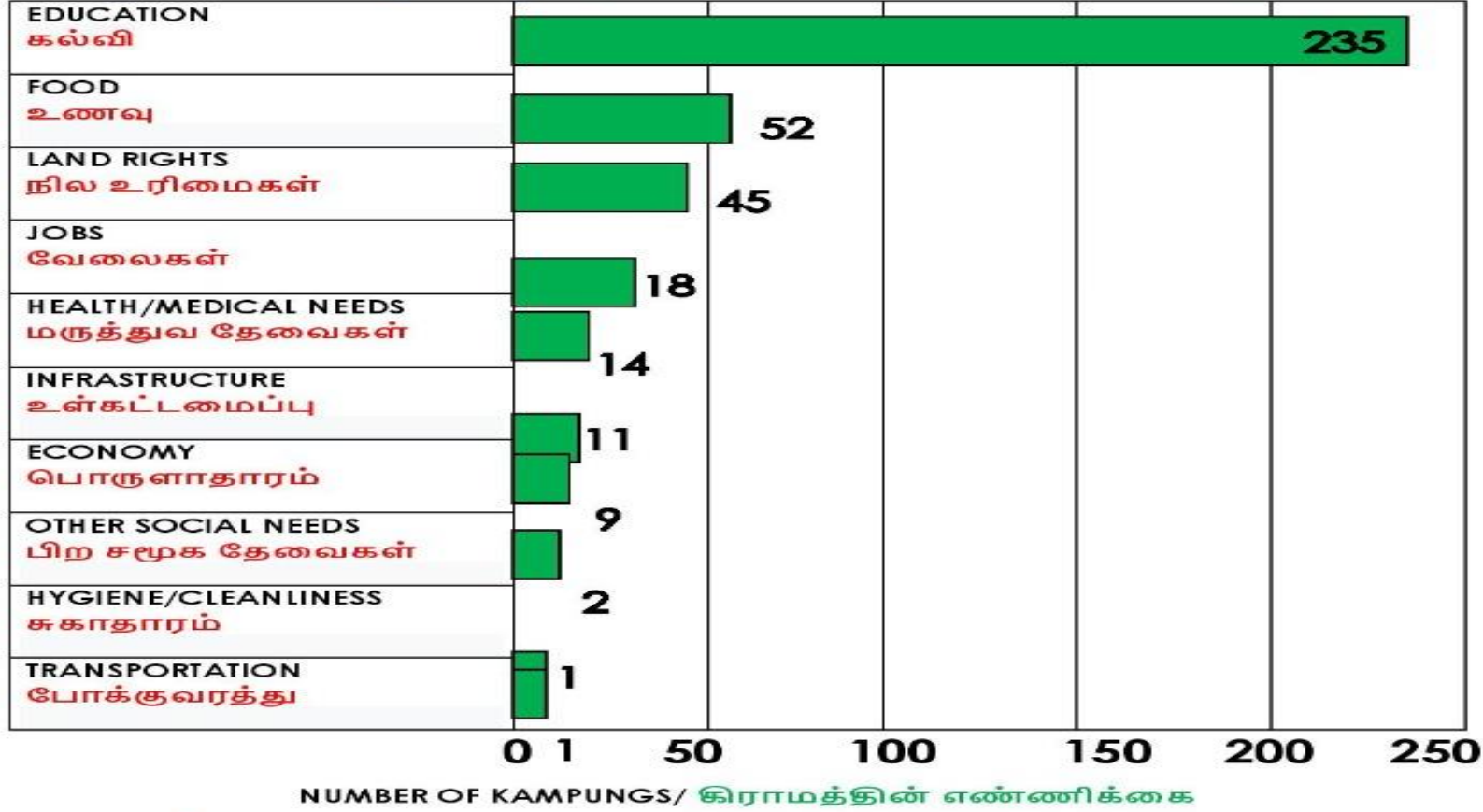
